Entry Fee

: Rs. 1500/- (payable to IABF)

Weight Class

: A team may consist of a maximum number of 13 Boxers.

No reserves are allowed.

Team Eligibility

: South India, North India, East India, North East India, West India &

Center India = Total 6 Team

Boxer Eligibility

Boxers between the age of 15 and 16 according to their year of

birth (born between January 1st, 2004 and December 31st, 2003)

are eligible to participate in the competition.

Weight Categories

44-46 kg, 48 kg, 50 kg, 52 kg, 54 kg, 57 kg, 60 kg, 63 kg, 66 kg,

70 kg, 75 kg, 80 kg, 80+ kg

Competition Format

: Three (3) rounds of 2 minutes, (one) 1 minute rest between

rounds.

Medical & Weigh-in

: General weigh-in and medical examination of all boxers will be held at the venue from 8 to 10 AM on 4th February, 2019

and on subsequent days for those boxers who are drawn

to Box.

Draw

: Draw will be held immediately on completion of the

medical & weigh-in on 4th February, 2019.

Team officials

: 1-6 Boxer(s) - 1 Coach-cum-Manager

6-13 Boxer(s) - 1 Coach & 1 Manager

One R/J will be allowed per Zone.

COACHES

- : Each Boxer will be entitled to be accompanied to the ring by up to three (3) coaches. However, only two (2) Coaches may mount the apron of the ring and only one (1) may enter the ring.
- All boxers must be accompanied by at least one IABF certified coach (1, 2 or 3-Star) at ringside during the bouts.
- All Coaches allowed to work in the Field of Play (FOP) must be IABF certified (1 to 3- Star).
- One of the 3 coaches can be replaced by an IABF Certified Team Cutman.
- Any coach of State Level, who has not certified through IABF, will not be allowed to access the FOP and must be registered as an Extra Official. d) Extra Officials Any individual who will be at the event in addition to the ones outlined in point 4.b., whom the

EQUIPMENT

: Gloves, Head Gard, Bandages will be provided by Organizing Committee – an IABF licensed supplier.

FLAG PARADE

: During the opening ceremony, up to two athletes from each team must be present for the flag parade. All athletes have to wear the full track suit – pants and jacket. More information regarding the participant's meeting location and time will be provided by the Local Organizing Committee.

COACH COURSES

: Coach Course Following latest IABF Rules' will organize a Coach Course prior the competition in order for each participating State/Board to have at least one certified Coach within its team at a reasonable cost. All NIS and National participation boxer Certificate are eligible to take this course.

REFREE/JUDGE EXAM

: R/J Exam Following latest IABF Rules' will organize a R/J 1 Star & 2 Star Exam prior the competition in order for each participating State/UT/Board to have at least one certified R/J within its team at a reasonable cost. All State R/J are eligible to take this course.

ARRIVAL PARTICULARS

: The Organizers will have their reception booth at Indore Junction Railway Station / Bus Stand. All team(s)/ official(s) will duly be received on arrival at Indore Railway Station upon receipt of prior intimation from the State/UT/Board(s) to the Organizing Secretary.

BOARDING/LODGING

: All Team Delegations must pay Rs. 200/- (Two Hundred) their Boarding/ Lodging charges as above for the entire Championships Period (February 4 – 7) by February 3, 2019.

Please note that accreditations for the Championships will be given only upon payment for accommodation.

WEATHER

: The weather in Indore in February is expected to be sunny with temperatures varying between 20-10°C.

IMPORTANT

- 1. The team/officials shall not arrive at venue earlier than the 3rd February and shall leave by 8th February, 2019
- Cost of travel of all participants and team officials up to Indore will be borne by the respective units.
- 3. No teams will be allowed to participate unless Affiliation/Entry fees are paid to IABF.
- 4. The championship will be conducted as per IABF rules.
- 5. Every team must have to deposit Rs. 2,000/- as security deposit for accommodation and the same will be refunded after the event is over.
- 6. All boxers must possess their own Gum shield, Red & Blue Vest & Shorts according to their respective corner allocation.
- 7. No type of body piercing and body accessories is allowed to be worn during the bout.
- 8. Borrowing of boxers from any other unit is strictly prohibited
- Person(s) accompanying the team as Coach and Manager will not be permitted to officiate in the championship.
- 10. Boxers who are already registered with IABF shall carry their Record Book/Indent Card otherwise they should carry their original Municipality birth Certificate, Mark sheet and School Certificate in which Father's Name, Mother's Name, Admission No., Admission years, Class and Date of birth.
- 11. All Boxers shall carry their Certificate of Junior Women Zone Boxing Championship 2018-19
