CASH PRIZE	:	Cash Prize each weight category:- Gold= 51,00/- Silver= 31,00/- Each Bout Looser = Rs. 500/- Team Champion = 51000/- Best R/J = Rs. 5100/-

LOC will award prize money in each weight category (subject to a number of key factors):

An Athlete must win at least 1 (one) bout in order to be eligible to earn the designated prize.

In case if only one boxer is present in a weight category such athlete will not be eligible to receive a medal and prize money.

If an Athlete has a win by Walkover (WO) and is a medalist, such Athlete is entitled to receive a prize.

If an Athlete has a loss and no wins and is a medalist, such Athlete is not entitled to receive a prize.

ENTRY CLOSE : January 15, 2026 (By Name)

No entry will be accepted after 15th January, 2026 under any circumstances.

TEAM ENTRY FEE : Rs. 2000/- (payable to LOC)

BOXER AGE ELIGIBILITY : A Boxer between the age of 15 years and below the age 16 years according to their year of birth are eligible to participate in the competition. Boxers born from January 1, 2010 to December 31, 2011 will be eligible.

WEIGHT CATEGORIES : The following thirteen (13) Weight Categories will be contested:
Weight Category 1. Pin 44-46, 2. Light Fly 46-48, 3. Fly 48-50,
4. Light Bantam 50-52, 5. Bantam 52-54, 6. Feather 54-57, 7. Light 57-60,
8. Light Welter 60-63, 9. Welter 63-66, 10. Light Middle 66-70,
11. Middle 70 75, 12. Light Heavy 75-80, 13. Heavy + 80

**DURATION AND
NUMBER OF ROUNDS** : Junior Boys' and Girls' Competitions, the Bouts must consist of three (3) rounds of two (2) minutes each. (One) 1 minute break between rounds.

MEDICAL & WEIGH-IN: General weigh-in and medical examination of all boxers will be held at the venue from 5 to 7 PM on 19th January, 2026 and on subsequent days for those boxers who are drawn to Box.

DRAW : Draw will be held immediately on completion of the medical & weigh-in.

REFEREE & JUDGE; One R/J will be allowed per team

COMPETITION REGISTRATION: All Boxers shall carry their Certificate of Junior State & District Boxing Championship 2026

Boxer who are already registered with IABF shall carry their Record Book/Indent Card otherwise State/UT Boxer they should carry their original Municipality birth Certificate, Mark sheet OR School Certificate in which Father's Name, Mother's Name, Admission No., Admission years, Class and Date of birth.

Board Boxer they should carry their original Identity Card and Joining Letter.

In order to stop participation of borrowed Boxers in the championship, the boxers shall participate only from his/her birthplace; must provide Municipality Birth Certificate/Domicile certificate/ Ration Card/ Jamabandi Nakal last 4 and School certificate/10th Mark Sheet, if requested to do so;

No teams will be allowed to participate unless Affiliation/Entry fees are paid to IABF. All boxers must possess their own Gum shield, Red & Blue Vest & Shorts according to their respective corner allocation. No type of body piercing and body accessories is allowed to be worn during the bout.

Cost of travel of all participants and team officials up to Venue & Food, Accommodation & local transport will be borne by the respective units.

ANTI-DOPING AND MEDICAL RULES Competitions must adhere to the IABF Anti-Doping Rules and the IABF Medical Rules. In all IABF Competitions, anti-doping tests must be conducted

AWARDS : Boxers/ officials- Merit & participant certificate, Winner Cup, Medal & Cash Prize each weight category

FLAG PARADE : During the opening ceremony, up to two athletes from each team must be present for the flag parade. All athletes have to wear the full track suit – pants and jacket. More information regarding the participant's meeting location and time will be provided by the Local Organizing Committee.
