



These Title Boxing Competition Rules apply to all Title Competitions that IABF associations and members of the boxing community must follow and respect in all of their Title boxing Competitions. No association may develop its own Title Competition Rules that are contradictory to these rules. However associations, for Competitions, may alter these rules to reflect regulations, as long as, the alteration does not diminish the rules, especially with regards to medical and safety requirements.

#### Age classification:

- The age of a Boxer is determined using his/her year of birth.
- Men and Women Boxers between the ages of 19 to 40 are Eligible.

#### Duration and Number of Rounds-

- Four (4) rounds of two (2) minutes, (one) 1 minute rest between rounds.

#### Official Draw-

- The Official Draw has to take place after the completion of the Sport Entries Check Meeting.
- It is mandatory that at least one Team Official of each participating Delegation attends both the Technical Brief and the Official Draw. This will allow for any omissions or weight category anomalies to be addressed and rectified at that specific time.
- An IABF point Scoring System is to be used for the Official Draw.
- Seeding Procedure- in the Competitions, seeding could be used.

#### Medical Examination-

- Within 30 days of all IABF-owned and IABF-sanctioned Competitions, Boxers must pass a medical examination with a Ringside Doctor or registered Medical Doctor to receive their completed, signed and IABF Medical Certificate.

#### Daily Weigh-in –

- During the Boxer's first Daily Weigh-In of the Competition, both the minimum and the maximum weight limits are controlled.

Following required for Registration:-

- If already registered for any IABF Competition, Boxers and Team Officials must provide a copy of their IABF Record Book.
- Only Boxer who will provide a copy of domicile or Municipality date of birth Certificate and Certificate of Title Boxing Championship-2023 will be allowed to compete from that team.
- Borrowing of boxers from any other unit is strictly prohibited.
- One time Registration & Record update/maintain fees for Officials & Boxers- Rs. 1000/-
- Signed Anti-doping Consent Form for Boxers only;
- Completed, signed, and stamped copy of the Medical Certificate for Boxers only;
- Signed Declaration of Non-Pregnancy for Women Boxers only;
- Submission of the Anti-Doping Consent Form
- A copy of the original laboratory documentation for Hepatitis B, Hepatitis C, and HIV tests must be done within 6 months, and must be presented together with the Medical Certificate.
- In all competitions, a Fit-to-box Form signed by the boxer, must be submitted to Technical delegate.
- For women Boxers who are under 18 (eighteen) years old, the Declaration of Non-pregnancy has to be signed by the Boxer and by at least one of her parents/legal guardians.
- In all IBA Competitions, a Boxer's IBA Boxer's Record Book has to be presented and validated at the Sport Entries Check for the Boxer to be eligible to participate in the Competition.
- The IBA Boxer's Record Book must be duly completed, including the medical section, and must be signed and stamped by the Secretary General or Executive Director of the Boxer's unit.
- Pregnant women are not allowed to box/compete.

The Team owner / Team delegations shall arrange their respective following facility:

- Boarding, Lodging and Local Transport.
- Sponsor their team.
- Team entry fee
- Team kit - Ceremonial dress, Track suit, Shoes, Socks, Hand Bag, Shorts & T-Shirt
- Sponsor logo on Team kit
